## **DIRECTIONS:**

The following directions are from Princes Hwy. (Thanks Neville!)

- If coming from the north, take the exit to Shellharbour on the new road about 3km past the McDonalds at Albion Park. This takes you to Shellharbour Rd. Then turn right at lights on to Tongarra Rd, veer left into Addison St, Turn right at Mary St, 2<sup>nd</sup> left on to Darley St, ahead to the Park.
- If coming from the south, take the left off ramp 2km north of Dunmore Station, across the overbridge and follow the directions as above.
