

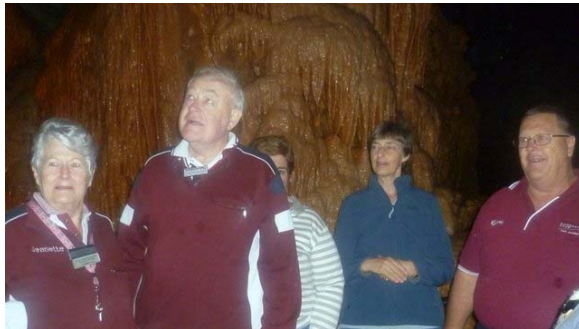
Oberon Rally – February 2013
